
Possible Solution

The painter had parts of several large buckets of red paint left from a bunch of different jobs. Determine to the nearest gallon how much paint was left.



Ben filled 3 cans and less than half of a fourth can, therefore to the nearest gallon there were 3 gallons of paint left over.
