

Possible Solutions

An example of the frequency table students could create is shown below.

Number of Books Read	Frequency	Relative Frequency
5-9	5	0.25
10-14	6	0.3
15-19	9	0.45
Total	20	1.0

The category they choose may differ, presenting different data for the table. For example, if they did 0-5, 6-10, 11-15, and 16-20 for their categories, the frequency and relative frequency would change as shown below.

Number of Books Read	Frequency	Relative Frequency
0-5	3	0.15
6-10	5	0.25
11-15	4	0.2
16-20	8	0.4
Total	20	1.0
