a) Tom had coins that totaled 33C. He counts the value of the coins:

10¢, 20¢, 25¢, 30¢, 31 c, 32 ¢, 33¢

Which coins does Tom have? Draw a picture to show your answer.
Tom has 2 dimes, 2 nickels, and 3 pennies.
b) Mary needs a pair of scissors for art class. The scissors cost 55¢ each. Mary has these coins in her pocket. Does Mary have enough money to buy a pair of scissors? Show how you counted her coins.


Mary has $65 ¢$ in her pocket. Yes, she has enough money to buy scissors.
